Arizona's Fire Service:

Established in 1998, the Arizona Fire Service Hall of Fame recognizes individuals who have made a significant, positive contribution to the Arizona Fire Service and their community. Please help us continue this tradition by nominating an individual that should be recognized for their contributions.

Individuals may be nominated based on their years of service, service on committees, state/national impact, educational impact, operational impact, contributions to community, organizational impact, legislative impact and any other area that may be applicable as an individual's significant contribution to the Arizona Fire Service and their community.

It is important to provide a detailed summary of the nominee's significant contribution(s) by fully completing those areas that apply to the individual. The focus of the nomination should be on the overall impact on the Arizona Fire Service. Nominations must clearly indicate an impact beyond the nominee's organization and must also be beyond the normal job requirements of the nominee.

Nominees previously submitted, but who were not selected, may be resubmitted.

Nominees selected will be inducted into the Arizona Fire Service Hall of Fame at the Opening Ceremonies of the 37th Annual Arizona State Fire School, September 9 – 12, 2010. Inductees will receive a personal commemorative plaque and a duplicate plaque will become part of a permanent Arizona Fire Service Hall of Fame display.

Please help us recognize the individuals that have made a significant contribution to Arizona's Fire Service and its communities. A nomination form has been enclosed for your convenience and is also available on our website at [www.dfbls.az.gov](http://www.dfbls.az.gov).
