

2009 FEMA-USFA FIRE DEPARTMENT CENSUS



U.S. Fire Administration (FEMA/USFA) is conducting their Fire Department Census update. All fire departments/districts should have received a letter from FEMA in October asking for your participation in the update process.

If you have participated in the past, regardless if you've received the letter or not, you are encouraged to participate in this census update by reviewing/updating your information either online or you may download their census form, complete the information, and fax or mail it in.

If you believe you are already in the FEMA-USFA database, then go to the following link and click on the "Change Listing" link and logon to review/update your information (follow the instructions on the logon page).

If you have not participated in this census in the past, or are not in the current FEMA-USFA database (new Department, merger with new FDID #, or similar), then you must register your fire department.
