Landmark Legislation Requires Trampoline Courts To Register with Arizona Fire, Building, and Life Safety

Department is ready to accept registrations

Phoenix, AZ- July 30, 2014-Effective July 25, 2014 trampoline parks must register with the Arizona Department of Fire, Building and Life Safety (“Department”) in order to operate in Arizona. This legislation is the first in the Country to be passed.

Each trampoline park in Arizona must provide specific business documentation to the Department on an annual basis. This documentation must verify licensure; insurance; successful ASTM standard inspection conducted by their insurer, and a log of any injuries in the park. All registration information will be posted on the Department’s website.

Trampoline parks are still a self regulating industry, and they were happy to take part in this legislation. It is believed this new registration will allow more transparency to potential customers. Currently, there are nine trampoline parks operating in Arizona.

Initial registrations must be filed with the Department by October 25, 2014.
